I am sending this in advance of our meeting. It may not make much sense until then, but I thought you may want to see where we are coming from. Essentially, it is a set-off – increase gas tax and decrease income tax. At this point, the amendment that he is going to propose is the last of the bunch. It increases the gas tax by 25 cents over 10 years and reduces the income tax brackets by 2% incrementally over the same time period.
