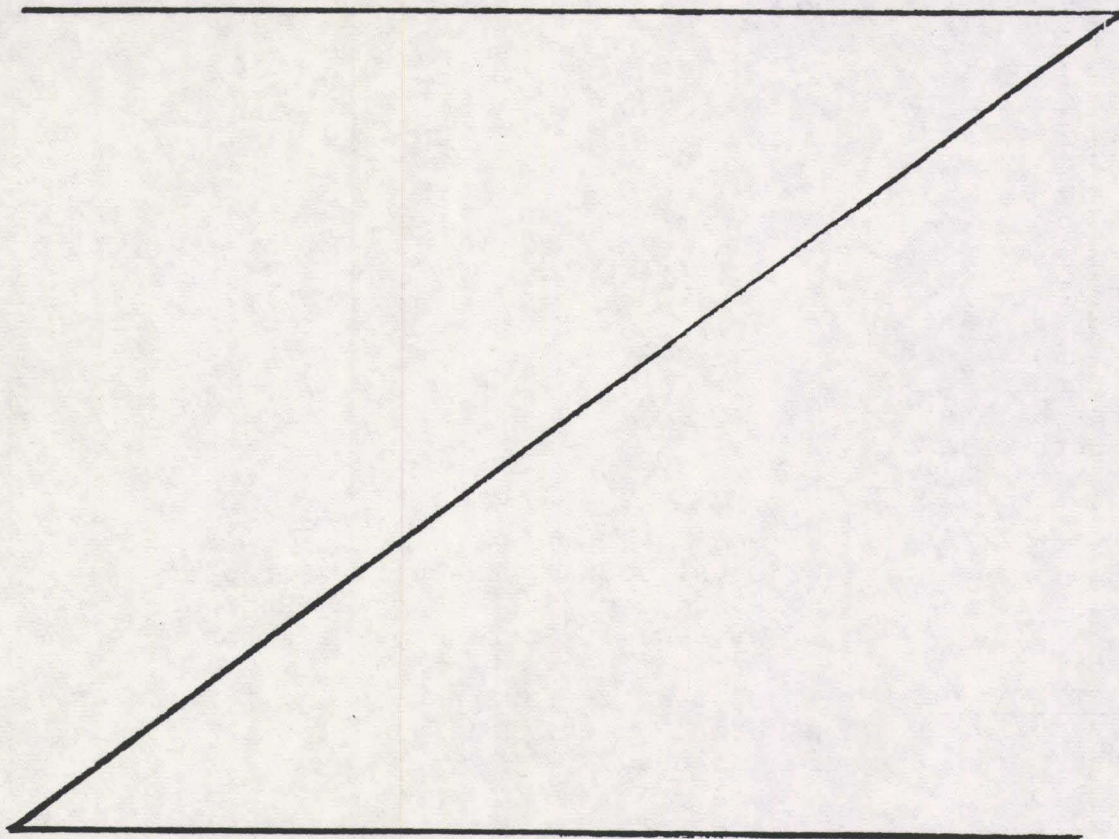

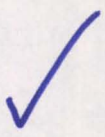

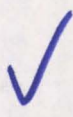

CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

Pursuant to the Commission's previous action on April 20, 1989, authorizing the Department to seek consultant services to perform inspection of treated wood products used in highway construction, the Department requests approval of a contract with A. W. Williams Inspection Company, Inc. in the amount of approximately \$15,000.00 per year. Work is to be funded under various programs.

Increase in Fees for Specific Information Service
("Logo") Signing Program

The last change in the fee schedule for the Specific Information Service ("Logo") Signing program, was made on June 1, 1984. The program is supposed to be self-supporting other than the 90% Federal Funds utilized in the original installation which was done by contract on each route, the last of which (I-85) is now being completed.

A review was recently made of financial records in an effort to ascertain the cost of the program and it appears to be self-sustaining at this time. However, there is a need to begin revamping the signs that were first installed (on I-95) and follow up in a systematic manner on the other routes as needed.

To facilitate record keeping and permit billing on a pro rata basis for months less than a year, it is desirable to have a fee in convenient multiples of 12.

It is recommended that the yearly renewal fees be increased from \$200.00 per mainline sign to \$240.00 and from \$100.00 to \$120.00 per ramp sign, effective July 1, 1989. No change is proposed in the flat rate fee of \$100.00 per business signs (mainline and ramp) for an initial installation after the original contract and for changing a business sign.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION
RIDERSHIP PROFILE AND MARKETING/PROMOTIONAL PROJECT

At the June 16, 1988 meeting of the Commission, the Department was given authorization in its public transportation program of projects under Items 19 and 20 to implement a ridership profile and marketing/promotional planning project. In addition, Item 11 was approved for State program administration purposes.
