We are in the process of preparing for the South Carolina Arts Awards ceremony on May 2nd, at which recipients of the Jean Laney Harris Folk Heritage Award and the Elizabeth O'Neill Verner Governor's Award for the Arts will be honored. As you may know, the South Carolina Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker of the House each make two appointments to the Jean Laney Folk Heritage Award Selection Committee. With this special connection, the Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker of the House sign the award certificates each year. These framed certificates are presented to the award recipients at the ceremony each year.
