Cuyahoga County Announces Legislation and Pilot for First County-Level PFS Program

Cuyahoga County Executive Ed FitzGerald announced that he will submit milestone legislation to establish the nation's first county-level Pay for Success program. Additionally, a pilot for Cuyahoga County's Pay for Success program has been made possible through a \$780,000 grant from the Laura and John Arnold Foundation. The philanthropic grant, which will not be repaid, will support FrontLine Service, Inc., a Cleveland-based social service provider that contracts with Cuyahoga County for homeless, crisis and trauma services. During the pilot, FrontLine will serve 33 mothers who have experienced homelessness and have at least one child placed in foster care. Third Sector is advising the County on Pay for Success.
