WHEREAS, these dedicated men and women contribute significantly to the quality of life in our state by working to make government services more accessible and responsive to the needs of our citizens; and


WHEREAS, South Carolina's public servants uphold the highest standards of citizenship, performing their duties with professionalism, teamwork, and leadership; and
