Chairman Mike Holden called the work session to order and Mr. David Watson gave the invocation. Everyone stood and pledged allegiance to the flag.

Dr. Mack Burriss, Chairman of the Anderson Care & Control Advisory Committee, began the work session by discussing proposed Anderson County

Ordinance #374 which he thinks is the answer to the dog problem in Anderson County. Council heard different peoples views on the ordinance. Mr. Banister said that he was opposed to a lease law, he did not ask for a new ordinance and would like to know who authorized the ordinance to be amended.

Council also discussed amendments (Ordinance #360) to the present Mobile Home ordinance and the need for the amendments to collect taxes on mobile homes. The proposed ordinance also adds skirting. Council heard from several mobile home dealers, park owners and others regarding the proposed changes. Council decided that all parties involved with the ordinance get together for possible changes that would be agreeable with everyone and postpone a vote on the ordinance until changes are made.


On the motion of Mr. Tolly, seconded by Mr. Holden, Council voted to go into executive session at 5:50 p.m. to discuss personnel for the position of County Administrator. Vote was unanimous.

On the motion of Mr. Floyd, seconded by Mr. Banister, Council voted to come out of executive session back into regular session at 6:45 p.m. Vote was 3-0. (Mr. Holden and Mr. Allgood had to leave prior to coming out of executive session.)

Mr. Martin reported that Council was briefed on 2 contractual matters and discussed personnel for the Administrator's position. No action was taken.

Mr. Tolly moved to adjourn at 6:55 p.m and Mr. Floyd seconded. Vote was 3-0.
