Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Councilman Joseph G. Wright, III gave the invocation.

Mr. Cary Chamblee with the South Carolina Land Resource Commission announced the availability of \$350,000 in Federal funds that could be used on Broadway. These funds would have to be matched with local funds and EPA needed a decision in a couple of week if Anderson County was interested in the funds.

The County Attorney discussed several possibilites of providing matching funds one of which was to create a special tax district within the geographical area surrounding the lake. Concerned citizens of the Broadway Lake Community were present and expressed their opinions on this matter.

On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Wiles, Council voted unanimously to ask Mr. Chamblee to get a 30 day extension from EPA for a decision from County Council. Mr. Poore was directed to check with the State to determine the circumstances under which they would agree to rebuild the bridge over the Dam and the County Tax Assessor, Heyward F. Crider was directed to determine the number of houses in that general area and the assessment values. Council postponed a decision until the requested information is provided.

County Council adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
