Governor Mark Sanford contacted our agency on your behalf regarding the recent change in the payment of your Medicare Part B premium.

The Qualified Individuals (QI) program ended June 30, 2008, because the federal government did not authorize the funds for Medicaid to continue to pay for your Medicare Part B premium. However, the federal government has reauthorized the program and is in the process of making these funds available to South Carolina. We are awaiting further word from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and will notify you if you may be eligible for the QI program in the near future.

We regret the inconvenience these changes may have caused you and your family. For possible assistance with your utility bills, you may wish to contact the Waccamaw Economic Opportunity Council, Inc., at (843) 234-4100.
