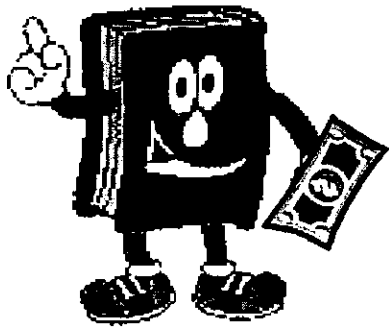
My name is Emmitt. I'm in first

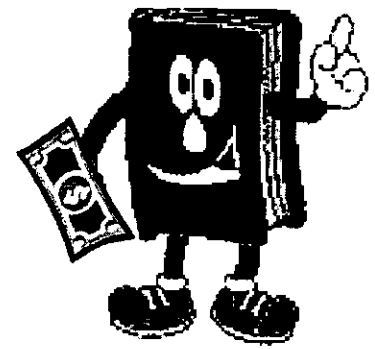
