**Start of 1987-88 Budget Preparation Process**

At this meeting, the Board launched the process for preparing its recommended operating budget for fiscal year 1987-88. This year, for the first time, a panel discussion on the broad functional area under consideration preceded the presentation of budget requests by the several agencies.

**1987-88 Budget Process: Education (K-12) Functional Area - Panel 1**

Panelists included EIA Blue Ribbon Committeeman William Page; Richland District 1 Superintendent John Stevenson; Teacher Barbara Deery; and Principal John Halfacre. Panel moderator was Dr. Terry Peterson of the Governor's Office staff and the Budget Division was represented by analyst Charles Case.

The Education Panel addressed the following issues:

- (1) A progress report, from a business perspective and from a principal's perspective, on the South Carolina education reform effort;
- (2) How South Carolina raises standards for college-bound students and, at the same time, reduces the drop-out rate;
- (3) How South Carolina can attract and hold outstanding teachers; and
- (4) Building Fund needs.
