

**A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

TO RECOGNIZE THE DEDICATION AND COMMITMENT OF SOUTH CAROLINA DOCTORAL STUDENTS COMPLETING THE SOUTHERN REGIONAL EDUCATION BOARD (SREB) DOCTORAL SCHOLARS PROGRAM.

Whereas, one of the goals of the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education is to promote quality and diversity in the academic offerings of institutions of higher learning; and

Whereas, in a time when there are so few minority faculty on college campuses in America and when there are not enough minority students seeking Ph.D.s, it is imperative that this State and the nation support those who make decisions and those who execute them to pursue Ph.D.s with intent of pursuing a career in academia; and

Whereas, the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education recognizes the value of intellectual breadth in graduate education, the importance of formal graduate study, and the diversity of students pursuing careers in postsecondary academia; and

Whereas, SREB Doctoral Scholars graduating from South Carolina institutions in programs leading to the Ph. D. degree during FY 2007-08 include Dr. Shane Davis, Ph.D. - Clinical/Community Psychology, the University of South Carolina; Dr. Cedric Fairbanks, Ph.D. - Civil Engineering, Clemson University; Dr. Dwella Nelson, Ph.D. - Analytical Chemistry, Clemson University; and Dr. Valeria Shipp, Ph.D. - Nursing, The Medical University of South Carolina; now, therefore,

Be it resolved that the South Commission on Higher Education conveys recognition of the dedication, commitment, and achievement of these doctoral graduates and commends the South Carolina General Assembly and all South Carolina Colleges and Universities for their support of the Doctoral Scholars program and for their continual advocacy for an environment that nurtures teaching, learning, research and scholarship, and values diversity; and
