SUMMARY REPORT

Meeting of Commission on Higher Education, August 29-30, 1983

On July 7, 1983, the Commission endorsed a cooperative agreement between the Medical University of South Carolina, the University of South Carolina, and the Office of the Governor, with representation from the Commission, to establish a coordinating board for medical education. Mr. Jacobs and Dr. Wells were elected by the Commission to serve on the joint board. The Commission received an informational report on the initial meeting of the board, held on July 19, 1983.

The 1983 Appropriation Act requires that the Charleston Higher Education Consortium submit its annual budget to the Commission for approval. The Commission approved the proposed 1983-84 budget in the amount of \$190,282 (including \$129,672 for personal service and \$39,087 for Other Operating Expenses).

The presidents of the public senior colleges and universities and the executive director of the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education presented their 1984-85 appropriation requests to the Commission. These requests will be considered by the Commission on September 8, 1983. The Commission is scheduled to make its recommendations concerning 1984-85 appropriations to the Budget and Control Board, the House Ways and Means Committee, and the Senate Finance Committee on September 14, 1983.
