



Alicia,

I received a copy of the log letter re: Figueroa and the Anderson office. I'm sorry you had to respond. The incident occurred on the day of our supervisor's meeting in Greenville. I received a full report that same afternoon - needless to say, our staff had a very difficult and unpleasant experience with Ms. Figueroa and the person accompanying her. She was seen and her determination made that day. We are experiencing a backlog of work and an overflow of applicants in Anderson; in spite of this, I can say the staff is being very attentive to customer service. However, some of our clients haven't been as patient as others. This was a situation that came close to our staff having to ask the folks to leave, but once Ms. Figueroa was taken back to a private office, the worker was able to take care of her application. The problem was more the person who was accompanying Ms. Figueroa (a relative, but not sure who it was - yelling, cursing everyone, throwing papers at the receptionist window, etc.). Regardless, just wanted to let you know we are trying very hard to keep problems to a minimum.
