Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, the use of illegal and prescription drugs and the abuse of alcohol and nicotine constitute serious threats to the success and well-being of our young people; and

WHEREAS, parental engagement in their children's lives is one of the most crucial factors in determining the likelihood of substance abuse by teenagers; and

WHEREAS, young people who regularly communicate and spend time with their families are less likely than the average teenager to smoke, drink, use illegal drugs, or abuse prescription drugs; and

WHEREAS, by connecting with their children throughout the course of the day, parents can help prevent substance abuse and strengthen the bonds of kinship which lead to lasting relationships.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim September 23, 2013, as

FAMILY DAY

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to recognize the positive impact of strong family interaction on the well-being and future success of the young people of the Palmetto State.
