An emergency meeting of the Anderson County Council was held on July 3, 1990 at 10:00 a.m. in the Conference Room - Administrator's Office - Third Floor. Chairman James M. "Jimmy" Cox, Jr. presided.

Chairman Cox called the meeting to order and explained that Mr. Hooper was out of town and unable to attend. He then explained the need for the emergency meeting was to put a ban on outside burning immediately because of the dry weather.

Mr. Cox moved to approve first reading of Ordinance #310 to ban any outside burning (any burning open to the atmosphere) violations to be maximum \$200 or 30 days in jail. Ms. Cahaly seconded and vote was four in favor and one absent (Mr. Hooper). Mr. Cox explained that Mr. Hooper indicated that he was in favor of the ordinance.

Mr. Cox explained a budget error (90-91) that involved Tri-County Technical College which required a vote by Council to correct. Mr. Banister expressed opposition to discussion and vote of other business than the reason the emergency meeting was called for. Mr. Cox explained that the news media was properly represented and announced as required and Council could act on other matters.

Council discussed a budget error which involved the capital improvement account for Tri-County Technical College. Mr. Cox moved to transfer any funds currently in the capital improvement account into the operations budget and any additional funds collected in that account throughout the year. This would require no new money only a transfer of funds within the budget for Tri-County. Ms. Cahaly seconded the motion and vote was four in favor and one absent (Hooper).

Mr. Cox asked that everyone refrain from fireworks near fields and use extreme caution where they are used.

There being no further business, Council adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
