My name is Tyler Griffin, I am the Vice President of the Winthrop University College Republicans. As part of our outreach this year we are conducting interviews with South Carolina conservatives. We were wondering if Governor Haley would be available for an interview? We film our interviews and we post them on our Facebook page as well as our YouTube channel. We use them as a way to get involved in the community, to give our organization something unique that it does, and for educational purposes. I've attached a picture showing our interview with Congressman Mick Mulvaney and with state senator elect Wes Climer. The interviews are run by myself and our Secretary of Affairs Leslie Lovett.

We would be willing to drive down to Columbia on a Tuesday or Thursday. Due to our class schedules the earliest we could probably be there is by 5:30-6:00. Although Tuesday and Thursdays are our ideal days, we could also do one on a Monday if need be. The only dates we can't do are Sept 22, Sept 26, and Oct 4th.
