I do have a question. How would I go about initiating a discussion at the state level so organizations outside of the SCHSL also having to comply? I recently discovered that USA Volleyball, who has a regional sanctioned group in SC doesn't have a concussion protocol - or at least they haven't been able to provide it in nearly 3 weeks now. They are negligent toward the health and well being of their athletes. I have started the formal complaint procedure with them, which starts with the offender - the regional commissioner (Jimmy Peden). I'm doubtful that will go anywhere.

While my daughter received a concussion, I'm not looking for any retribution, only that organizations wishing to operate in SC have a written protocol and that they be required to follow it. Having a trainer on site should be a requirement - or at least someone trained in recognizing a concussion.
