## **YOUTH WATERFOWL HUNT AT SAVANNAH NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE**

Are you a youth hunter, 15 years of age or younger, looking for a waterfowl hunting opportunity? Wait no more! The Savannah National Wildlife Refuge (NWR) will host its 16<sup>th</sup> annual youth waterfowl hunt on three separate Saturdays; one in November (11/18/17), one in December (12/16/17), and one in January (1/20/18). Interested youth hunters must apply for the hunt by September 30, 2017.

The hunt will be limited to a maximum of 12 youth hunters (two per blind) per day who will be selected by random drawing on October 5, 2017. Applications for the drawing must be received at the Savannah Coastal Refuges Complex headquarters or postmarked by September 30, 2017, and a \$5.00 application fee per hunter is required at the time the application is submitted.
