WHEREAS, while there are no cures for learning disabilities, proper support and intervention can lead to success for those affected.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim October 2014 as

LEARNING DISABILITIES MONTH

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to help raise awareness of learning disabilities and the benefits of proper identification and support.
