Dear Mr. and Mrs. Collins:

Congressman Joe Wilson contacted our agency on your behalf regarding your concerns over Medicaid eligibility and the healthcare needs of Mr. Collins.

Unfortunately, your family's current monthly income is above the allowable limit of \$1,167 for Mr. Collins to qualify for Medicaid's Aged, Blind or Disabled program. Income is based on gross earnings and does not allow deductions for taxes, utilities, car payments, or other living expenses.

We have enclosed information on a number of healthcare and prescription programs for people without health insurance coverage. Another healthcare option is the Medically Indigent Assistance Program (MIAP). This program sponsors inpatient hospital coverage for individuals who lack financial resources to pay for their care and whose income is below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. If you would like more information about MIAP, please call Ms. Brenda Martin in Richland County at (803) 434-3834.
