Lexington County – HAZ/MAT

At 10:32, Saturday, 1/17, the State Warning Point was notified that a chemical spill had occurred at the Wal-Mart Store at [5556 Sunset Blvd.](#) in the Town of Lexington, resulting in the evacuation of the store. The spill occurred when an employee unknowingly mixed cleaning chemicals.

[At 11:52](#), the Lexington County Emergency Management Director reported Lexington City Fire Dept., City Police Dept., EMS, and DHEC are on scene. One (1) person was transported to the hospital and several employees reported irritated breathing. Wal-Mart called in a contractor to assist with the cleanup.

The Contractors removed the chemically contaminated liquid from the store and Wal-Mart reopened [at 21:00](#) hours.

No requests for state assistance have been made. No further action is expected.
