Our office received your Freedom of Information Act request for copies of the following:

“[A]ll emails South Carolina Governor Nikki Haley sent or received between June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015, and December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016, that contain the following key words and/or phrases...: United Nations, France, Russia, Britain, United Kingdom, UK, China, PRC, Taiwan, India, Syria, Iraq, Iran, [and] North Korea.”

Our office will provide any and all public records in our possession that are responsive to your request, subject to any exemptions or redactions as allowed pursuant to Section 30-4-40(a) of the South Carolina Code of Laws or as is otherwise exempt from disclosure by statute or regulation or prohibited from disclosure by court order.

Due to the high volume of Freedom of Information Act requests received by the Governor's Office and the significant costs associated with producing the requests, our office will charge a reasonable cost for searching and copying records as allowed pursuant to Section 30-4-30(b).

Our office has identified records responsive to your request. We are currently compiling responsive records to determine an estimated cost and will notify you as soon as a cost estimate has been determined.
