Be on the lookout: Your 2017 tax rate notices are coming

You should receive your 2017 tax rates notices by the middle of November. The rate is applicable for wages paid between Jan. 1, 2017, and Dec. 31, 2017. Individual rates are based on an employer's computed benefit ratio. The tax rate class assignment in the notice should be used for the full calendar year. Please note that tax rates are applicable to the first \$14,000 each employee earns.
