
Dear Governor Haley:


Hope For You is a volunteer Christian ministry dedicated to sending Bible study lessons to those correctional facility inmates who request them. After reading the lesson content the student answers question booklets which are returned to us in postage pre-paid envelopes. Their answers are read, commented upon and the inmate prayed for. A new lesson is then forwarded until the entire series is completed, Genesis through Revelation. At inmates' requests we have also sent Bibles and devotional materials.

We, along with other such groups, i.e., Forgotten Man, have and are experiencing facility mail personnel resistance, delays and in some cases non-delivery of materials with Christian content.

At the same time Muslim personnel and materials are allowed free inmate access. The reality of today's world is that jails and prisons are not able to function with any degree of prisoner rehabilitation. Prisons are widely acknowledged to be centers of Muslim radicalization. The only true change of any individual's heart comes from within.

We are asking for your help in opening the communications which will permit the Good News of the Gospel to all in your state's correctional facilities who ask. And we prayerfully thank you in advance for your willingness and ability to accomplish these good works.
