SECTION 1: The Minutes of the meeting of January 18, 1990; copies of which have been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting monthly reports as published by the Department of activities of the month of January, 1990.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving purchase order issued for amount in excess of \$1,000.00 during the month of January, 1990, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion concurring in the action of the Department in entering into an agreement with the County of Greenwood to replace a substandard timber bridge owned and maintained by CSX Transportation, Inc. at an estimated cost of \$438,000 with the County paying 20%, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into a supplemental agreement with Greiner Engineering Sciences, Inc. and the LPA Group to provide construction engineering services for the proposed Isle of Palms Connector, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Frank Coleman and Associates for consultant services to multilane U. S. Route 78 from S. C. Route 302 in Aiken to I-26 in Aiken, Barnwell, Bamberg, Orangeburg and Dorchester counties at an estimated cost of \$250,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the City of Rock Hill to enter into an agreement with the LPA Group/Campco Engineering to provide engineering services for the multilaning of S. C. Route 161 at an estimated cost of \$1,100,000, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into a contract with Post, Buckley, Schuh & Jernigan, Inc. for preparation of plans for the Laurens Bypass, in the amount of \$785,730.78, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion concurring in the action of the Department in entering into an agreement with the Joint Venture of Deleuw Cather/LPA Group for consultant services to upgrade a portion of U. S. 521, at an estimated amount of \$359,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into contracts with the LPA Group and HDR Engineering, Inc. to perform statewide county bridge inspections and ratings, at a cost of \$993,703.49, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 11: The Commission unanimously passed a motion allocating \$14,278.61 State Highway Funds for capital improvements/land and buildings, in order to close the following accounts:



FOREST HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM
GREENWOOD COUNTY

The Department proposes to enter into an agreement with Greenwood County for the purpose of replacing a substandard timber bridge owned and maintained by the CSX Transportation, Inc. along a county owned road (Lorenzo Road). The necessary approach work thereto is also included. The estimated construction cost for the project is \$438,000. Under the terms of the agreement, the County would pay 20% of all costs connected with the project with the remaining 80% coming from Forest Highway Funds allocated to the Department.

It is recommended that the Commission concur in the Department's entering into this agreement with the County of Greenwood.

GREINER ENGINEERING SCIENCES, INC., AND THE LPA GROUP

The Department requests Commission approval to enter into a supplemental agreement with Greiner Engineering Sciences, Inc., and the LPA Group to provide construction engineering services for the proposed Isle of Palms Connector in Mt. Pleasant, S. C.

This project will extend from U. S. Route 17, north of Mt. Pleasant southerly for approximately 3.88 miles to its termination at the S. C. Route 703/14th Street intersection on the Isle of Palms.

This agreement is anticipated to be funded by Federal Aid Emergency Relief (ER) funds.

AGREEMENT FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES

Pursuant to the Commission's previous action of April 20, 1989 authorizing the Department to seek consultant services to multilane U. S. Route 78 from S. C. Route 302 in Aiken to I-26 in Aiken, Barnwell, Bamberg, Orangeburg and Dorchester Counties, the Department requests concurrence to enter into an agreement with Frank Coleman and Associates, in the estimated amount of \$250,000.00. Work is to be funded under the SHIMS Program.

AGREEMENT FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES

The Department requests approval from the Commission authorizing the City of Rock Hill to enter into an agreement with The LPA Group/Campco Engineering to provide engineering services for the multilaning of S. C. Route 161 from I-77 to S. C. 5 and the Extension of Dave Lyle Boulevard from I-77 to U. S. Route 521 in Lancaster County. The estimated cost for Phase I of the agreement is \$1,100,000. Funding will be from the SHIMS program.
