1) Please RSVP by 5 p.m. on Thursday, April 23, 2015 to attend the briefing. If you have not pre-registered by the deadline, you will have to go through the regular security line and entry screening process.

In the body of the email, please provide your name, affiliation, and the name of additional guests who will be joining you. **Due to space limitations, we ask all organizations to limit their participants to no more than three.**

3) Arrive early, preferably between 8:15 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. All pre-registered guests should be prepared to show a government-issued photo ID to sign in at the registration desk in the DOE lobby to receive your Visitor’s Badge.

4) To further expedite your entrance (and exit) to the building, we ask that you not bring any cameras or electronic equipment (such as tablets or laptops) to this event. People who bring tablets or laptops will be required to register them and receive a property pass allowing them to enter and exit the building with the equipment.

5) Due to the short timeframe, we will not be able to generate the necessary clearances to accommodate foreign citizens.
