We met earlier this year as a part of the Succeed SC initiative with DEW and also later as we met with Governor Haley and several of the technical college presidents to discuss her interest in making sure this initiative happens. I am writing you regarding another matter which I hope will be of interest to Governor Haley.

The Governor was instrumental in Continental Tire of the Americas deciding to locate in Sumter, South Carolina and she was here in Sumter in October, 2011 when the announcement was made to bring Continental Tire to South Carolina and specifically, Sumter.
