The Boeing South Carolina Supplier Summit will bring together the leaders of Boeing's major suppliers to attend a two-day conference in Charleston and discuss specific focus areas including, production rates, IP, and updates, etc. Between 65 -70 companies are expected to attend, with 1-2 representatives each. Approximately 15% are SC companies, the rest are located throughout the U.S. and the world.

Purpose of Speech: To brag on Boeing to their major suppliers AND to sell SC as a great place to do business.

Audience: 120 people representing 61 current suppliers of Boeing, including dozens of international companies, which means that there are roughly 50 prospects in the room. (Less than 10 companies are based in SC, including GKN, T-I-G-Hitco, Adex, D-3 Technologies, Dynamic Solutions, Jacob-Grey, J.I.T. Manufacturing, and UEC Electronics.)

Commerce Prospects: Warren Darby and Chuck Bundy are attending the conference to target certain companies; it would be appropriate for you to recognize them or reference their attendance as your representatives; if time and logistics permit, then Warren will link up with Courtney to make key introductions.

Talking Points:

- ***Important: Do NOT reference the fight with the NLRB.***

- Welcome – it's a great day in SC; welcome to Charleston, which became the #1 tourist destination; notably, after Boeing came here;
- What Boeing means to SC – shot in the arm, great American company, true source of pride; put us on the map, opened the door to the aerospace industry, recognize some friends in the room for GKN and T-I-G-Hitco; the excitement of the first 787 Dreamliner rolling out onto the tarmac; becoming a part of the fabric of SC, contributing to the community, becoming the presenting sponsor for the RBC Heritage;
- Thanking the suppliers for supporting Boeing – commit to the suppliers that taking care of Boeing is taking care of SC; brag on the suppliers; Boeing couldn't do what it does without the suppliers; together, "we build dreams";
- Why suppliers should consider moving to SC – low cost of doing business, low utility rates, and low unionization rate; tort reform, tax reform, and regulatory relief year after; streamlined permitting processes; tailor-trained workforce with ReadySC; and a first-class 21st Century infrastructure plan (the Port, dual rail, inland port, and roads).
- What a company will get it if it does business in SC – the Governor as its #1 employee, a "Team South Carolina" approach to economic development, a true partner in the state, and a high quality of life.
- Thank everyone – enjoy the conference; enjoy Charleston.

About Boeing South Carolina:

- EMPLOYEES: 6,394 employees (70-75% from SC; 85% from local region) and creating 2,000 additional jobs by 2020.
- SUPPLIERS: 345 suppliers /vendors in SC purchasing over \$110 million worth.
