In the FY 2016-17 Budget passed by the SC General Assembly this June:

- Governor Haley recommended and the General Assembly appropriated \$29 million for K-12 technology. \$29 mil also appropriated in FY 14-15 and FY 15-16.
- Governor Haley recommended and the General Assembly appropriated \$3 million for mobile access to high speed internet for underserved children.
