**Hurricane Patricia**, the strongest hurricane ever recorded by the National Hurricane Center -- with winds of up to 200 mph -- made landfall early Friday evening on a sparsely populated stretch of Pacific Mexico coast. The eye of the hurricane landed near Cuixmala in the state of Jalisco, sparing major cities and popular resort towns and cruise destinations, like Puerto Vallarta and Manzanillo, from direct hits.

Cruise lines scheduled to call at Pacific Mexico ports monitored the situation closely. Princess Cruises

rerouted the Ruby Princess from its scheduled port call on Friday at Cabo San Lucas; the ship instead spent the day at sea and returned to Los Angeles on Sunday.

The hurricane weakened rapidly as it moved across the interior. At this writing, no casualties due to the storm were reported, though thousands of homes were damaged.

**The Norwegian Escape makes its debut voyage this week**, a trans-Atlantic crossing from Southampton, England, to Miami. Norwegian's largest ship to date -- weighing 163,000 tons and accommodating up to 4,200 passengers -- will then sail Caribbean itineraries from the Florida city.
