Thank you for considering this. The hearing will be held November 30<sup>th</sup>. Time TBD. Three person hearing panel, all attorneys.

The parties will be the Richland County Recreation Commissioner Board Members. The RCRC is a separate entity from the County itself. There are seven Commissioners appointed by the Richland Delegation that oversee the RCRC. One has resigned. The six remaining are:

There is no other "party," however, a majority the Richland County delegation has called for the removal. The remaining delegation members are not asking for removal. But in case there could be a conflict, they are Senators Darrell Jackson, John Scott, and Representatives Dr Bales, Christopher Hart, Leon Howard, Joseph Neal, Todd Rutherford, and Ivory Thigpen.
