Description/Significant Features:

A one and one-half story, Craftsman-style, frame residence; full-width, gabled front porch is an extension of the main roofline, which is supported by paired square columns that rest on brick piers. The front elevation is three bays wide, with a central doorway, with six-pane Craftsman-style sidelights; the door is flanked by a tripartite window on either side: eight-over-one, Craftsman-style, double-hung, wooden sash flanked by single four-over-one, Craftsman-style, double-hung, wooden sash. Gabled end has a tripartite window. Northern elevation has single eight-over-one, Craftsman-style windows and large shed-roofed dormer with a ribbon of four eight-over-one windows.
