Hi Chaney,

For a story on Confederate battle flag license plates, a question: Is Gov. Haley moving to rescind the Sons of Confederate Veterans specialty plates the state issues? Last Thursday, the U.S. Supreme Court ruled that states may decide what messages to print on their plates, effectively reversing a Fourth Circuit decision that required S.C. to put any message a private sponsor wanted on the plates. (In Virginia, Gov. McAuliffe said today that he would seek to rescind the Confederate plates, and Maryland lawmakers are calling for similar action.)
