Under the act, this request is considered approved unless written notification of your response is mailed or personally delivered to me within 15 days of this letter. A response stating merely the request is being processed is not sufficient to comply with the act.

If all or any part of this request is denied, please cite the specific exemption(s) you think justifies your refusal to release the information to me and inform me of appeal procedures available to me under the law.
