As a member of the ONE SC Grants Committee, you will be responsible for:

- Understanding the scope of need across our state
- Reviewing the grant applications and, with the other members of the committee, determining what grants will be awarded
- Determining the process for future RFPs (geographic priority, organizational capacity, etc.)

The first Request for Proposals, RFP, opened on November 2 and closed on December 4. In order to award our first grants before the end of the year, our committee must meet this month. I have attached a Doodle Poll with possible meeting dates. The meeting will last approximately 90 minutes. Please respond as quickly as possible. Once we receive your responses, we will schedule the meeting. (We will provide a webinar option for this meeting.) The meeting will have three objectives. The first, to understand the scope of need across our state. Colonel Kevin Shwedo, who has been tapped by Governor Nikki Haley to act as the state's coordinator for flood recovery, will attend the meeting and will provide us with a report that details the damage across the 24 affected counties. The second, to review the current applications and determine what grants will be awarded. The third, to review the available dollars remaining and discuss the process for future RFPs.
