Governor,

I have written you before and the Executive Director of the DMV. You referred me to a staff assistant, Amy Hornsby, who did not return my calls.

I have a simple question:

In March of 2014, I was stopped and cited for driving under suspension, 3rd offense.

I had just gotten my license back, so I had a legitimate license in my possession. The Clover, SC police would not look at my receipts or documentation and I was sent to jail. I had to get a lawyer who got my status changed to Driving Under Suspension, first offense. Upon payment of \$652 I would have been able to get my license back. Due to my being ill and was defrauded, I was never able to pay the fine.

This has been horrible for me. I was stopped again in September of 2014. This has led to me b being unable to drive, losing my job, and being classified as a felon. This eliminates the possibility of my being re-employed with any major corporation.

I just really need to know how this could happen. Why, when I had a legal driver's license with me, was I sent to jail.

I believe that the subsequent charge is invalid as the illegal stop in March of 2014 invalidated the second stop.
