HILTON HEAD ISLAND, S.C. — Defending Champion Matt Kuchar and runner-up Luke Donald have both committed to the 47th annual RBC Heritage Presented by Boeing. The Team RBC Ambassadors will compete in South Carolina's signature golf event April 13-19 over the famed Harbour Town Golf Links on Hilton Head Island.

They are joined by past champions Graeme McDowell, Stewart Cink, Glen Day, Jim Furyk, Justin Leonard, Carl Pettersson, Brandt Snedeker, Tom Watson and Boo Weekley. Also committed are John Daly, Ernie Els and David Toms.

Kuchar won the 46th annual RBC Heritage in dramatic style, holing a bunker shot for birdie on the 18th hole to earn a final day 64 and a one-stroke victory. It was the Team RBC Ambassador's seventh PGA TOUR win and capped a stretch of four consecutive top-five TOUR finishes. It also helped earn him a spot on his third consecutive U.S. Ryder Cup team. The Sea Island, Georgia resident is currently 10th in the Official World Golf Rankings. He has competed in the RBC Heritage 11 times since turning pro in 2000.

Donald began last year's final round over the Harbour Town Golf Links in the lead by two shots over John Huh and four shots ahead of Kuchar. Kuchar's 7-under 64 earned him a one-stroke victory over his fellow Team RBC Ambassador, who had previously earned three top-three finishes in his eight starts at Harbour Town. Donald has earned five victories on the PGA TOUR and eight International titles. The Englishman now calls Chicago home since graduating from Northwestern University with a degree in Art Theory and Practice.
