Thank you for being a part of Pawmetto Lifeline's breed request program. I am writing to notify you that Pawmetto Lifeline has just rescued a lovely little Yorkshire Terrier that I thought you may be interested in! Her name is Aloe and she is 2 years old and weighs 5 pounds. She is sweet and lovable although shy at first. Aloe is currently at Pawmetto Lifeline if you would like to come and meet her. I have attached a few photos for your review.

The adoption fee for Aloe is \$325 and includes the spay surgery, getting her up to date on her vaccines and flea and heartworm preventative, and microchipping. Because you are a member of the breed request program, you are being notified about Aloe 24 hours before the public. Please remember, however, that adoptions are on a first come first serve basis and that Pawmetto Lifeline does not hold a pet for anyone, unless they are willing to pay the non-refundable adoption fee. As always, members of the Breed Request Program have the option to adopt Aloe site-unseen by paying the non-refundable adoption fee with a credit card over the phone.
