Addendum to Application for Boards, Commissions and Committees

- 18] Have you ever been arrested for a crime other than a minor traffic violation? Yes
If so, give details*
- a. When I was approximately 19 years old, my sister, who has since been deemed mentally incompetent by the Richland County Probate Court, called the Forest Acres Police Department and alleged that I was assaulting her. Two officers responded, and I met them in the front yard of my parents' home. I asked to speak with them privately to discuss my sister's mental status. They refused, and ordered me into the house. In the heat of the moment, I unfortunately insisted too strongly that they meet with me outside of my sister's presence. One of the officers gave me the choice of going inside the house or going to jail. I turned my back and placed my arms behind me indication my choice. I was handcuffed, taken to the Forest Acres Police Department, photographed and fingerprinted. After further investigation including determining my sister's mental state, I was released approximately an hour after my arrest. To my knowledge and recollection, no formal charges were brought, and if they were, they were dismissed without a court appearance.
- b. In March 1990, I attended the men's Atlantic Coast Conference Basketball tournament in Charlotte, North Carolina with several friends. During the game, one of my friends was arrested for what I remember to be Disorderly Conduct or a similar charge. After his arrest, he called the arresting officers, "Sandinistas". As he was taken away, his forehead was drug along the concrete wall opening a cut to his forehead. A few minutes later, my friend's girlfriend and I went to the "police station" located in the basement of the Charlotte Coliseum to lodge a formal complaint against the arresting officers and to check on my friend's physical condition. The "police station" was actually a large open room in which my buddy was sitting. After being refused the opportunity to speak with a supervisor, I tried several times to speak with my friend across the room. For doing so, the officers arrested me and charged me for what I recall was "Interfering with an Officer in the Course of His Duties", or the like. I was arrested and taken to the Mecklenburg County Detention Center where I was held overnight. In the morning, the Magistrate dismissed the charges against me sua sponte.
- 23] Have you been party (plaintiff or defendant) in any state or federal litigation for the preceding five years? Yes If so, give details.*
- a. The law firm of which I am a partner, was named as a defendant in an action filed in Colleton County, South Carolina on March 30, 2012 entitled, "*Janis D. Headden vs. Hetrick Law Firm,*" and being Case Number 2012-CP-15-00247. The action was dismissed on September 16, 2013.

27] Have you ever been disciplined or fined by the State Ethics Commission? Yes If so, give details.*

a. I was fined \$100.00 in August of 2013 by the South Carolina State Ethics Commission. I completed my 2013 Statement of Economic Interests Form online prior to the submission deadline, but without realizing my mistake, I only saved the form online as opposed to saving and submitting the form. The \$100.00 penalty was paid and Statement was successfully submitted.


