WHEREAS, science and mathematics are vital components of a well-rounded education, helping our children to succeed in today's technologically advanced society; and

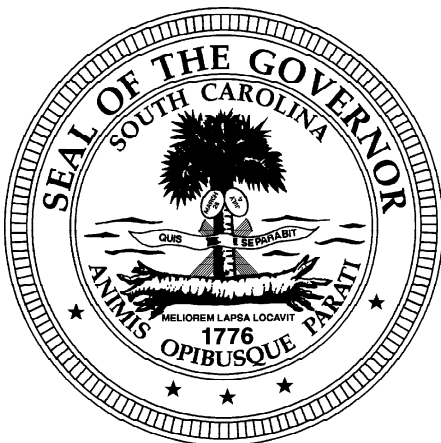
