Aquaculture Association to meet

The S.C. Aquaculture Association is inviting aquaculture farmers, suppliers and anyone interested in entering the aquaculture field to the Association's annual meeting.

The meeting—called S.C. Aquaculture 2000—will be held on Jan. 20 and will offer individuals an opportunity to interact with aquaculture researchers from throughout South Carolina and business management experts from the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Meeting organizers will also provide updates on the latest aquaculture information, from here and across the country.

Leaders of regulatory agencies that affect aquaculture as well as state legislators will discuss topics relevant to the aquaculture industry and how aquaculture advocates can better interact with South Carolina legislators.

USDA crop loss program in place

Farmers are eligible for \$1.2 billion from the federal Crop Disaster Program for losses to 1999 crops if they sign up before Feb. 25.

Farmers who lost crops because of adverse weather and other related conditions are eligible for up to \$80,000 per person in crop-loss aid. Insured, uninsured and noninsurable crops are all eligible. Any farmer who benefits from the program is required to insure all insurable crops of economic significance in 2000 and 2001.

No one with an annual gross income of \$2.5 million or more is eligible. For more information, call your local Farm Service Agency or (803) 806-3856.

Seminars teach quail management

S.C. Bobwhite quail populations have been declining in the past 30 years, according to the Department of Natural Resources, and DNR, along with the S.C. State Committee of Quail Unlimited, will hold the 13th annual Wild Quail Management Seminars.

The seminars, designed to instruct landowners and land managers in the proper techniques of creating habitats that will support native populations of bobwhite quail, will be conducted March 2-4 at the Webb Wildlife Center in Hampton County. The registration fee is \$60, which includes meals, overnight accommodations and seminar materials.

Field demonstrations and classroom instruction will focus on habitat practices including firebreak establishment, prescribed burning, timber management, brush control, discing for natural foods and supplemental feed patch plantings. Presentations will be given on wild quail natural history, biology, diseases and parasites, predation and other factors that may be contributing to the population decline. Speakers will include wildlife and forestry professionals from state and federal agencies.

About 700 people have attended the seminar since it began in 1987, and they have positively affected the quail population. Space is limited, so register early to reserve a spot in one of the two sessions. For more information, call the DNR Small Game Project at (803) 734-3609.

Livestock farmers get assistance

Livestock farmers in selected counties may receive financial assistance for grazing loss.

Counties now included in the LAP assistance program are Chester, Fairfield, Abbeville, Greenwood, McCormick, Oconee, Cherokee, Spartanburg, Union, Chesterfield, Greenville, Lancaster, Newberry, Edgefield, Lexington, Pickens, Saluda and York. To be eligible for assistance, farmers must have suffered a 40 percent or greater grazing loss for three consecutive months during the LAP payment period approved for each county. Commissioner's Column

Agriculture 2000 and Beyond

During the last 100 years, we have observed a host of spectacular events—many of which have had a positive effect on agriculture. During that time, men landed on the moon, the information superhighway was formed, and other phenomena occurred. But, the invention of the car, truck, train, and airplane as well electricity, refrigeration, pasteurization, and the computer chip probably had the most significant impact on agriculture in the past century.

Agriculture has been and must continue to be a part of this rapid change. All of us need to be more mindful of the fact that agriculture provides a plentiful supply of food, fiber, and shelter to sustain life for the ever-increasing population on this earth. We need to understand that farming is not easy and that it is becoming more and more difficult for farm families to stay in business.

In the last 100 years, scientists have focused on improving crop varieties and animal breeds—work that continues today. Also, the inspection system was created to protect consumers, and the weather service was established to provide information vital to farming.

During the 1900s and before, South Carolina led the way to progress in building the first steam locomotive for regular railroad service, developing the first commercial tea farm, building the first cotton mill, and establishing the first textile school at what is now known as Clemson University.

We have also witnessed in the last century events that have been serious threats—World Wars I and II, *The Great Depression*, droughts, floods, other catastrophic events like hurricanes and tornadoes, extremely low farm gate prices, and the reduction in farm numbers. There has been a significant decline in farms and farmland acreage, not only in South Carolina but also throughout the nation. One of our earliest records (from 1930) documenting the number of farms shows that South Carolina had 165,000 farms with an average of 70 acres each. The total farmland then was 11.5 million acres. Now, we have 25,000 farms with an average of 196 acres each and a total of 4.9 million acres of farmland. At the same time, acreage per farm has increased and farm efficiency has hit a record high.

In addition to the change in the number of farms, the rural to urban population ratio has changed. Today, about half of the state's population live in rural areas and half live in urban areas. I don't believe that this was caused so much by a mass exodus of people from the country to the city, but by the fact that the city itself has moved into the country—a phenomenon that we now call "urban sprawl." In some cases, it is more profitable for a farmer to sell his land for housing or industrial development than it is to farm it.

Imagine, if you will, the future—some of the things that might be—possibilities that are not too far-fetched to become realities in a few short years.

Think about the production of new crops like "cuphea" which produces an oil used for vegetable shortening and soap products, milkweed fiber for comforter and pillow fillings, and "euphorbia" for use as an ingredient in paints and coatings.

And, to improve their odds against the weather, instead of day-to-day information, farmers could have seasonal advanced knowledge of the weather possibly offering insight into what and when to plant. Scientists will be able to select desired traits for traditional and non-traditional crops faster through a new field of biology called "bioinformatics" which incorporates genetics, computer science and mathematics. Think of a cherry tomato that can reduce the risk of prostate, lung, and other cancers.

Envision farm animals as livestock "drug factories." Think of a single goat that could be genetically engineered for blood-clotting factors to sustain the medicinal needs for the entire world's hemophiliacs.

In the future we will continue to see changes in farm management

New Year's Collard Greens

Ingredients: 1 bunch (5lbs.) collard greens, 1/2 lb. lean pork, 2 quarts water, 1 med. onion, chopped, 1 teaspoon seasoned salt, 1 teaspoon sugar, 1 teaspoon vinegar

Directions: Check leaves of collards carefully; remove pulpy stems and discolored spots on leaves. Wash leaves thoroughly; drain well and chop. Set aside. Cut pork into 1/2-in. thick slices. Cook in an 8-quart Dutch oven until golden brown. Slowly add water and bring to a boil. Add collards and other ingredients. Cover, reduce heat, and simmer 30-45 min. or until collards are tender, stirring occasionally. Yields 6-8 servings.
