December 23, 1958

The State Budget and Control Board met in the Governor's office at 3:30 P. M. on December 23, 1958. All members of the Board were present.

The Board approved the issuance by Clemson College of \$650,000.00 of Dormitory Revenue Bonds if the application therefor established eligibility under the law and the Board's regulations.

Senator Ed Baskin, of Lee County, the County Superintendent of Education, and the Chairman and other members of the County School Board, appeared before the Board in connection with a requested loan to Lee County of \$187,000.00 for the construction of a Negro School building.

Senator Baskin objected to the loan through the present school board. He stated that the County Treasurer also opposed it, and had stated that he would not sign a note for the loan. The County Treasurer had not joined in the application for the loan, as was specifically provided in the enabling Act.

In view of these circumstances, the Board concluded that the application was incomplete and took no action on the matter.

The Board approved a loan of \$50,000.00 to Laurens County.

The Board then adjourned.
