As you can imagine, folks in the Graniteville area are having a very difficult time with the situation that has developed in the city from the train accident; closing of the textile mill and everyone losing their job to the problem with the Public Service Commission concerning the astronomical unjustified water rate increases. This forced the Aiken Delegation into negotiations with the Valley Public Service Water System to help on that end.

My plea to you is to please offer any assistance available to Mr. Grover and his family. If I can offer further information, please do not hesitate to contact me. Once again, thank you for your assistance.

CT Abdomen and Pelvis without and with Contrast

Indication: Urinary tract infection. Pneumonia.

Technique: Spiral scan of the abdomen and pelvis was performed using an index of 5 mm pre- and post-administration of non-ionic intravenous contrast without adverse reaction.

Findings: There is evidence of coronary artery disease. The lung bases are clear. The liver, spleen, and pancreas are unremarkable. The gallbladder is without radiopaque calculi. No biliary or pancreatic ductal dilatation is identified. The adrenal glands are thin. There is symmetric renal enhancement. There is moderately severe hydronephrosis of the left kidney with a dilated tortuous ureter to the level of the pelvic brim at which point there is a 22 mm long by 10 x 13 mm transverse calculus within the distal left ureter. The bladder is asymmetrically thick-walled with loss of the normal fat plane between the sigmoid colon and left bladder fundus. Note is also made of numerous diverticula of the sigmoid colon. A very small amount of gas is seen within the wall of the urinary bladder as well as within the lumen of the urinary bladder near the fundus. There is a considerable amount of formed stool throughout the colon suggestive of severe constipation. There is fusiform aneurysmal dilatation of the infrarenal abdominal aorta which attains a maximum diameter of 4.1 x 4.5 cm. The aneurysm tapers towards the bifurcation. Ectatic iliac arteries are noted bilaterally. No free intraperitoneal fluid or gas is identified. There is however some stranding of the mesentery adjacent to the loop of sigmoid colon and urinary bladder.

Impression:

1. Appearance worrisome for fistulous connection between the sigmoid colon and fundus of the urinary bladder likely secondary to chronic diverticular disease.
2. 22 x 10 x 12 mm distal left ureteral calculus with moderate obstructive changes.
3. 4.1 x 4.5 cm infrarenal abdominal aortic aneurysm.
4. Clinical correlation with severe constipation recommended.
