- WHEREAS, since it began 25 years ago, the AT&T South Carolina African American History Calendar has assisted educators and the State Department of Education in meeting the statutory requirement to include African American history in South Carolina's curriculum; and
- WHEREAS, the South Carolina African American History Calendar, presented by AT&T, has become a Hall of Fame, honoring individuals whose contributions have enriched the Palmetto State; and
- WHEREAS, the 25th Anniversary Edition will highlight 12 significant events which have helped lay the foundation for our state's diverse culture; and
- WHEREAS, AT&T and its partners - the State Department of Education, the University of South Carolina, WIS-TV, The State Newspaper, and South Carolina ETV - will celebrate 25 years of the AT&T South Carolina African American History Calendar project with the unveiling of the 2014 edition of the History Calendar on October 30, 2013.
