**A D Jordon, from Senator Tim Scott's office stepped forward and introduced himself. He passed out the Senator's contact information and stated that both he and Mr. Scott were available to discuss citizen's concerns and questions.**

**Anne Sutcliff came to the podium and again expressed concern about the Litter Control Ordinance and being required to clear and/or clean up her property. She stated that she had not been allowed to dump at several County Convenience Sites in the past. She feels she has been singled-out by staff. Councilwoman Cooper-Smith stated that she would hear from someone regarding her concerns.**

**Johnny Bruner from Holly Hill stated that he was also having Litter Control problems. Part of his property is manicured but he has intentionally let the grass grow on another part to deter theft on his property. He has received a violation letter from Litter Control. He also has concerns about the sale of two acres of his property when a canal was built and stated that it has not been settled. Chairman Wright said that Council needed more information and they could not solve those issues that evening.**


