Commissioner's Column

National Pork Month . . .  
focuses on pork's value, versatility

"Pork. The Other White Meat" is featured every October during National Pork Month. Consumer information and major promotions with restaurants and food service operators are especially the focus this time of the year.

National Pork Month first began in 1972 to promote the versatility and wide variety of pork available to consumers. This month is traditionally the time of year that most hogs are marketed, resulting in a large supply of pork and the best value for consumers. To encourage consumers to purchase more pork through retail and foodservice, the SC Pork Board supports year-round checkoff-funded promotions, especially during the month of October.

Since 1987, U.S. pork producers and pork importers have invested in the nationally legislated pork checkoff program. In 2001, the checkoff program at the national level is expected to generate more than \$50 million providing funds for research, promotion, and consumer information projects. A variety of state and national programs, directed by the pork producers themselves, include: advertising and consumer information, retail and food service marketing, export market promotion, production improvement, education and technology, and swine health, pork quality and safety.

Pork Month activities include special promotions with grocery stores, restaurants, and consumers. The checkoff-funded "National Eat Dinner Together" campaign began in 1996 to encourage and capitalize on an emerging trend of families and friends spending more time dining together. But, the "Pork. The Other White Meat campaign" is the foundation for checkoff-funded pork advertising and promotion. Research shows that consumers remember the slogan. Pork is the only commodity product ranked in the study of well-known enduring product brand names because of the slogan.

While our producers are doing a good job promoting their product, I am deeply concerned about low prices and new regulations that threaten the stability of our state's swine industry and our ability to produce quality food for our country. State emergency regulations are in place that may become permanent in the near future.

These proposed regulations would drastically alter the pork industry in SC, affecting any pork producer who has a large facility that produces one million pounds of hogs each year. The combined weights of all swine facilities owned by a producer within 25 miles of a new or expanding facility would be used to determine the size of a proposed facility, if the combined weight exceeds one million pounds. The 25-mile setback would, in essence, prohibit future production in South Carolina. Also, the regulations specify that any pork producer would need to provide a financial assurance fund equal to 10% of the cost of the facility plus the full cost of a closure based on a closure report. The fund would be adjusted annually for inflation. This would be a blow to the state's pork industry. No facility would be able to set aside such a large amount. But, even under these circumstances, I am proud of the fact that our producers continue to provide a fine quality product. And, I am equally proud of the SC Pork Board for using their checkoff funds wisely.

On behalf of everyone involved in SC's pork industry, I encourage you to buy pork---a truly valuable and versatile product. Pork is not only nutritional, but it is economically valuable to our communities, generating jobs among suppliers, producers, processors, handlers and other related businesses.

So, join me in a salute to our pork industry. Let's get back to the basics. Since the theme for this year's Pork Month is "Cookin' Up Conversation," get the family together, serve your favorite cut of "Pork. The Other White Meat," and cook up a conversation with family and friends.
