The State Budget and Control Board met in the office of the State Auditor at 10:30 A. M. on Friday, November 3, 1950.

The following agencies appeared before the Board and presented their budget requests for the fiscal year 1951-52.

Department of Labor
The Code Commissioner
The Adjutant General
Department of Public Welfare

The Board then adjourned until 3:00 P.M., at which time it reassembled in the office of the State Auditor and heard the following agencies.

S. C. Industrial Commission
State Forestry Commission
State Highway Department

Mr. Sam B. King, Director of the Sinking Fund and Property Division of the Budget and Control Board, appeared and submitted a proposal whereby, through reduction in premiums because of sprinkler installations, savings would total a sufficient amount to retire a loan of \$53,230.00, to be made by Winthrop College, in about 7½ years. The Board authorized the Director to proceed with the negotiating of this loan and other such loans to State institutions and political sub-divisions of the State, when such loans can be retired in a period of 10 years.

The following allotments from the Civil Contingent Fund were granted by the Board.

For an additional probation officer for 7½ months -	\$2,500.00
\$1,650.00, and travel in the amount of \$850.00	
<u>Tax Commission</u>	
For rent of the first floor of the Waters Building	2,300.00
to April 1, 1951 and incidental expenses involved thereby.	

The Board then adjourned to meet on Tuesday, November 7, 1950.
