**The Internal Operating Budget:**

- Other Operating includes contractual services, supplies, rent, travel, and equipment.
- Employer Contributions represent the fringe benefits paid on employees' behalf.

**Flow-Through Funds:**

- are disbursements passed through to other institutions or agencies by the Commission.

**Budget Surplus:**

- Except where noted, any surplus will be carried forward into the general operating budget for the next year.
