Today we staged the areas and showed them on a map – we staged the areas as the threat at the moment is further out for northern counties because the storm slowed down. We will address Georgetown and Horry later today, but stated those areas will be staged for evacuation tomorrow. Zones are not given for those areas because we are watching the weather to determine what needs to be evacuated. We will have press announcement momentarily that you can send him.
