Ary entered foster care in October 2016. She was placed with us in Jan. 2017 after several transitional visits during the month of December. Her original foster parents had issues with her brother, Conner, on his behavior. They asked he be moved and then decided to close their license so we took Ary.

Ary was originally very bonded with Conner but that has drastically faded. Conner was placed in a foster home in Oconee and six months into the case moved to IN with his bio father. Ary's parents have not visited with him since he entered care in Oct. 2016.

We had Conner for the day in Feb. 2016 and he spoke very openly about his hate for Jordan (Ary's dad) how he beat him up and he wished he would die. He even explained to us how he would kill him when he got strong enough to.

Ary's parents have not provided any material things for her (other than a few toys) since they were court ordered to pay child support in early 2016. Prior to that, they provided two boxes of diapers (two sizes too big for Ary) and some snack foods and a container of juice.

They have been to every visit with her. All of which are during lunch time and they've never provided food for her. I've had to pack her lunch each time. They also never change her diaper. Her visits take approx. five hours (1.5 hours transportation, one hour visit, one hour therapy, 1.5 hours transportation.) She was once returned to daycare saturated in pee. It was soaked through her diaper, pants, socks and shoes.

Her parents just recently set their social media accounts to private but post completely inappropriate and vulgar things. Screenshots to prove. Jordan openly talks about drugs (smoking and growing) on his Instagram.

Rob (neighbor that supported them) has been to every visit. He knew about the neglect and never did anything about it. Ary is also scared of him and has said multiple times she doesn't want him to be at the visits, yet he is still allowed. No treatment plan has been offered to him.
